#### 76/21 Lower Stamphill Allotment site

There were no quotes or reports to consider in respect of the Marestail on the Lower Stamphill allotment site. The Clerk provided an update that two local grounds contractors had declined the invitation to quote. Due to the nature of the weed, Councillors will need to consider a chemical treatment later in the growing season. At the invitation of the Chairman, members of the public spoke about Marestail infestations on other allotment sites. The allotment inspection will take place on 7<sup>th</sup> August and a full list of works can be drawn up for further review by Councillors.

## 77/21 Defibrilators

Cllr Jerome provided details of a pledge of funding from The Clarke Foley Charity. They wish to support the defibrillator expansion program in Addingham by fully funding the new device at Olicana caravan park and will contribute £1632 to cover the cost in full. Ongoing costs of maintaining the devices were considered and it was **Resolved(1):**To authorise the Clerk to place an order for a full defibrillator set up to be installed at Olicana caravan park, costing £1632. To provide invoices to the Clarke Fowley Charity for the promised reimbursement of the same amount.

**Resolved(2):** To authorise the Clerk to place an order for a new set of pads for the defibrillator at Memorial Hall, costing £43.20.

The owners at the Craven Heifer Public House have granted permission for a defibrillator to be installed on an exterior wall at the pub.

**Resolved(3):** To authorise the Clerk to place an order for a box and battery for the existing defibrillator (currently in storage) to be installed at The craven Heifer, costing £835.20. To place all orders together and incur one deliver fee of £6

**Resolved(4):** That ongoing costs for consumables and batteries be met by the Parish Council and that funds be committed for this purpose each year.

## 78/21 Village Noticeboards

Councillors reviewed the condition of the 3 village notice boards.

**Resolved:** That the Clerk be authorised to obtain quotes for consideration at next meeting.

## 79/21 Christmas Market

A request from Totally Locally for a grant to pay for the Christmas Market expenses was received and noted. The

Resolved: That a £2000 grant be authorised for Totally Locally to meet the expenditure outlined for the safe running of the Christmas Market in 2021. That the Clerk be authorised to make this payment.
