### 65/22 Energy Costs for Council Owned Buildings

The Clerk presented a series of contract options for the supply of electricity and Gas to the Old School, Hub building. Council noted the end date of the current fixed price contract with British Gas of 15<sup>th</sup> April 2022. Council noted the prevailing market conditions of price increases in the wholesale energy market. After discussion it was **Resolved(1)**: That the Clerk be authorised to make necessary arrangements with British Gas Lite to enter into a 12 month fixed price electricity contract with charges of 37.01p/kwh and 33.47p/day.

**Resolved(2)**: That the Clerk be authorised to make necessary arrangements with British Gas Lite to enter into a 12 month fixed price Gas contract with charges of 12.710p/kwh and 45p/day.

**Resolved(3)**: That the Clerk report the overgrown trees to Bradford Met and ask them to crown lift the large trees in the area.

<u>Resolved(4)</u>:That the Clerk obtain quotes for the installation of ramp access for the patio of the garden area near to the War Memorial.

Resolved(5): That the Clerk obtain quotes for wooden bench seating to compare with the steel option.

Resolved(6): That the Clerk obtain quotes for the replacement of the patio area in a suitable surface material such as flags, large blocks, asphalt and like for like
