- b. To receive the oral report from Councillors following their inspection of the trees at the rear of the Stamp Hill allotments, situated on the footpath at the entrance to the Nature Reserve.
- c. To consider appointing an arborist to provide a quote for tidying the high branches, removal of two deceased Ash trees and any other works considered necessary for the adequate maintenance and safety of the area.
- d. To consider appointing a contractor for the regular strimming/mowing of the car park and entrance way around plot 1a on Lower Stamp Hill Allotments.
- e. To consider appointing a contractor to remove the branches from plot 8a Silsden Road and to decide on action as necessary.
- f. To consider appointing a contractor to remove the broken up fencing from the entrance to plot 26 Stamp Hill and to decide on action as necessary.
- g. To consider appointing a contractor to remove 6 large tyres from Stamp Hill allotments in order that the plot can be re-let to a resident on the waiting list.
- h. To consider an honorarium payment to the volunteer mower at Newtown Allotments for this season.

8. Nature Reserve

- a. To consider a scheme of work at the Nature Reserve to replace areas of worn and damaged fencing. If thought fit, to authorise the Clerk to invite local contractors to quote for the work.
