Clerks report on matters Arising – report for information

- The Clerk has requested that the sand and fencing, left on site by BMDC contractors, be removed from Silsden Road park. Site visit by Clerk on 14th November to confirm fencing now removed and sand washed away. Item closed.
- Despite extensive drain repairs on Skipton Road and resurfacing of the highway, water continues to spill onto the road near Heathness Road. The Clerk has chased several times during August, September and October and together with Cllr Whitaker we now have a resolution: The team have identified the pipe which was broken and have replaced it. Second to that they are installing an inspection chamber on what was the broken section of pipe to help with any problems in the future.
- The Clerk has reported all the gullies on Silsden Road. They are all full of debris which
 is at least 2ft deep. (reported 22/10). Update 02/11 they will be cleared w/c 6th
 November. *Update site visit by Clerk on 14th November identified that gullies had
 not been cleared. Reported again to Paul Naylor
- Clerk has escalated the previous request for a new bin at the bus stop on Main Street opp. Cricket Club. There is no update
- Clerk has followed up a concern from a resident regarding the Public Right Of Way at the top of Stockinger Lane. Officers have agreed to visit. Chased on 19th September. Update received to confirm that following a site visit, officers have placed remedial work low on the list of priorities. Update on 22/10: The path has been partially cleared by a volunteer. BMDC Rights of Way team will return to widen the dug out area. There is no update
- Clerk has chased the ongoing matter of 20MPH zone on the Big Meadow Drive Estate. Clerk has referred the matter to Highways via District Cllr Whitaker. There is no update
- The clerk has reported the overgrown hedgerow along the full length of Ilkley Old Road. Requesting that contractors from BMDC come and cut back as soon as possible. There is no update
- The Clerk has begun enquires with local bus companies regarding the removal of the Skipton Road bust stop signage. West Yorkshire combined Authority have confirmed that the bus stop is still used for a seasonal service (April – End Sept) to operate the 903 service to Brown Bank Caravan Park. The stop will not be removed.
- The Clerk has received an enquiry from a resident regarding the maintenance of a large overgrown flower bed on land at the corner of Old Station Way and Main Street. Clerk has made enquiries with BMDC.
- Cllr Cobley has reported 2 media cabinets to Virgin Media as they require a coat of paint. Locations: Bark Lane and Green Lane. (Telephone 0345 454 1111) Clerk to follow up in January.
- A volunteer cllr has removed and disposed of fly tipped tyres from the Nature Reserve. (in accordance with correct waste disposal methods at Keighley depot)
- The Clerk has received notification from residents that parking tickets were issued on 28th November in the Main Street Car park. The Clerk has followed this up with BMDC and all tickets have been waived.
