

The Addingham Parish Council meeting held on Monday the 9<sup>th</sup> May 1949

The minutes of the previous meeting were read confirmed and signed by the Chairman

Apologies for absence were received from Cr Lumley & Cr Whitaker

It was resolved that a letter be sent to Cr Lumley expressing the Council's wish for a speedy recovery

Automatic Traffic Signals A letter was submitted from the West Riding County Council stating that the erection of the traffic control signals has been provided for in the 1949-50 Estimate

Gas Supply A letter was submitted from the Ilkley Urban District Council stating that steps are being taken to eliminate the trouble of poor gas supply in the Moor Lane District

Allotment rents A letter from Mrs Throup was read regarding the charge for the allotment rent and this was referred to the Clerk for the necessary adjustment

Allocation of Council Houses A copy of a letter which the Addingham British Legion had forwarded to the Surveyor of the Skipton Rural District Council regarding the claim of an Addingham resident for one of the Council Houses was submitted. It was resolved that this letter be forwarded to the Selection Committee of the Skipton RDC for their consideration

War Memorial Plaque Fund The Clerk reported the receipt of further donations in connection with the appeal recently made and reported to date £61.5.6 had been received
