Public Conveniences Letters were submitted from the Clerk and the Surveyor to the Skipton Rural District Council stating that the Surveyor had been instructed to prepare plans and estimates of the cost with a view to putting the work in hand shortly. The Rural District Council asked for suggestions as to how many the conveniences should accommodate and it was recommended that the Ladies section should have 6 WC’s & the Gents 6 urinals and 6 WC’s

Playground Equipment A letter was submitted from the West Riding County Council Education Department regarding the cost of the proposed Junglegym which was considered excessive and asking the Council to recommend a cheaper one. It was resolved that we press for the original one which had a slide as prices may have reduced since December 1948. If however the West Riding County Council propose to instal a cheaper Junglegym will they first approach us before obtaining same
