Chairman's Illness The Chairman referred to the absence of Cr Adams through indisposition and trusted he would be restored to health again. All members expressed there sympathy with Cr Adams and it was resolved that the Clerk convey the Council's good wishes and that he would soon be well once more

Minutes It was resolved that the minutes of the previous meeting be signed

Low Gas Pressure A communication from the Gas Engineers asking for particulars of the nature of complaints it was resolved we point out it took 27½minutes to boil a kettle of water on a gas ring and when a second gas ring was lit in the same house both went out, also that gas officials had made tests and instead of the pressure being 6 it fell to 1

Damaged fence near Suspension Bridge It was resolved that the legal position regarding the liability of the Council be ascertained should they resolve to repair the Fence near the Suspension Bridge

Traffic signs Bolton Road Junction It was resolved that the Member of Parliament notice be drawn to the refusal of the Ministry of Transport to erect Traffic signals at the junction of Bolton Road and asking him to use his efforts to influence the Minister to vary his decision

Unfit Lamp & charges It was resolved that the lamp which had been unlit on Bolton Road at the foot of Bark Hill be reported to the Gas Board and at the same time make enquiries regarding the charges for gas and services during the period when lamps are unlighted
