Proposed abandonment of Lighting & Watching Act. Arising out of a letter from the Clerk to the Skipton Rural District Council it was resolved that we thank him for his observations and at the same time enquire if any estimate could be given of the rate in the £ per annum and also if it would be levied on the whole Townships should the Lighting & Watching Act 1833 be abandoned

Straight Lane. It was resolved that we ascertain who gave authority for Straight Lane to be repaired as far as Scar Ghyll and upon whom did the cost thereof fall

Gas Charges. Arising out of a letter received from the North Eastern Gas Board it was resolved that they be asked to explain the difference in the terms "Labour" and " maintenance"

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War Memorial Plaque. Arising out of a letter received by the Chairman from the Addingham Welcome Home and Remembrance Fund per Mrs E Lumley stating that the undistributed balance amounted to £36.10.3 which they recommended to be used for the purpose of defraying the cost of the Memorial Hall Plaque 1948-49 was on for the renovation of both Plaques it was resolved that the Council appreciated the recommendation and thanked the Secretary of the Fund for the cheque for £36.10.3 enclosed with the letter and would be happy to use the gift for the purpose indicated
