Minutes of previous meeting. It was resolved that the minutes of the previous meeting be signed

School Lane site. A letter was read regarding the road to the Housing Site at School Lane stating that it was intended to make up the section of School Lane where the boundary walls had been demolished during the present financial year and that the Surveyor to the Skipton Rural District Council did not think there was the slightest hope of the County Council authorizing any work on the remaining section which extends up to the Green

Street Lighting. A letter was read from the Clerk of the Rural District Council regarding change over from Gas to Electricity but it was decided to await the receipt of a further communication before taking any action in the matter

Proposed new Agreement with Ilkley UDC. It was resolved that before accepting the proposal by the Ilkley Urban District Council to be responsible for the maintenance from the base of the Lamp column onwards further information regarding the cost thereof should be forwarded

Concrete Cricket Pitches. It was resolved that tenders be obtained for the laying of concrete pitches in Recreation grounds
