Straight Lane. Arising out of correspondence regarding the repair of the road from Turner Lane to Scar Ghyll it was resolved that we thank the Surveyor for his letter and suggest that he has misunderstood our correspondence as the Council desired to know who repaired the road from Turner Lane to Scar Ghyll and who paid for same

Mr Flints Property. A letter was received from Mr Flint offering to sell his property in Addingham resolved that he be thanked for same and said that his letter be forwarded to the West Riding County Council to see if they were interested

Wayside seats. A letter was read from Mr JH Howden regarding the provision of seats and enclosing a copy of a letter from the Clerk of Skipton Rural District Council regarding the powers of a Parish Council to provide and maintain seats in streets and public places, it was resolved the application be made to Minister of Health for the grant of such an order

Rights of way. It was resolved that the Council meet on Monday the 16th June to consider the footpaths survey and that the maps prepared in 1932 be obtained from the Skipton Rural District Council for reference

It was resolved that a meeting be arranged with a deputation from the Skipton Rural District Council's Housing Committee and a deputation from the Addingham Parish Council to discuss and clarify the position regarding the numerous complaints received in connection with the new houses
