Minutes. It was resolved that the minutes of the previous meeting be signed

Caravan Site. Arising from a letter received from the Sanitary Inspector it was resolved that we write him stating it is not understood why the unauthorised Caravan site is allowed to continue and if the same is not cleared shortly we shall take further action in the matter

Greenage receipts Bowling Club;s payment. It was resolved we write the Secretary of the Bowling Club regarding the greenage receipts and asking for a record thereof for this season, at the same time pointing out that we should like to know when the Council will receive their share of the receipts

Public Conveniences. It was resolved that we thank the Surveyor for his letter with reference to the Public Conveniences and asking that we should like to know whether the site has now been acquired and if not what is the cause of the delay

Rest room for the Aged. It was resolved that the West Riding Council be written regarding the need for a Rest room for the aged in the village and asking what they proposed to do in the matter

Sunday Games Memorial Close. It was resolved that further advice be sought regarding the playing of games on a Sunday at the Memorial Close

New Council Houses Street Lamps. It was resolved the street lighting of the New Council Houses should be electricity and that an estimate of the cost thereof be obtained

Repair of footpath Main Road Corner Stone to Sandbed. It was resolved that we write the West Riding County Council again pointing out the necessity of carrying out urgent repairs to the footpath between Corner Stone & Sandbeds

New Council House Lettings. It was resolved that this Council are of the opinion that the system of selecting tenants for the New Council houses was very unsatisfactory – deserving cases were overlooked and in two instances there was no case to justify the Housing Committee agreeing to select these persons thus preferring them to the those whose present accommodation was appalling. In these circumstances it was further resolved that Skipton Rural District Council Housing Committee be requested to inform this Council their method of choosing

tenants and in future will they consult us before making their final choice especially so as it seems to be the practice of the Rural District Council officials to refer prospective applicants to the members of the Council

Gate by Manor House. It was resolved that the gate be repaired by Manor House
