

The Addingham Parish Council meeting held on Monday the 9th October 1950

Caravan Site. A letter was considered which had been received from the Sanitary Inspector stating that until the Rural District Council Sub committee had made their report nothing could be done in the matter

Greenage receipts Memorial Close. The Clerk reported that the Addingham Bowling Club were not in a position to prepare their financial statement at present but hoped to do so during the month. It was resolved that they be requested to forward the statement before the November Council meeting

National Assistance Act 1948. A letter was considered regarding the provision of a rest room in Addingham for the aged which had been received from the West Riding County Council and it was resolved that the same be forwarded to the Clerk of the Skipton Rural District Council to ascertain what should be done in the matter

Repair of footbridge near Gatecroft Farm. It was resolved that Mr EH Eastwood be asked to repair the footbridge near Gatecroft Farm and that Messrs H Brear & Sons provide the necessary timber

New Council Houses Street Lighting. It was recommended that Concrete pillars should be erected for the proposed lampillars on the New Housing site

Repair of pavement Corner Stone to Sandbeds. A letter was received from the West Riding County Council stating that nothing could be done at present to raise the kerb between Corner Stone & Sandbeds but the matter

would be kept in mind for inclusion in future estimates

It was resolved that the West Riding County Council be asked what they they suggest can be done for the protection of the school children who use that portion of the road daily

New Council Houses. It was reported to the meeting that as no reply had been received from the Skipton Rural District Council regarding the enquiry as to how the Council Houses are allocated

Minutes. It was resolved that the minutes of the previous meeting be signed

Memorial Tablet. It was resolved that Mr Charles Barritt's tender of £17 for cleaning off paint from the Tablet and rubbing the face of same ready for painting of letters be accepted

Late postal deliveries. It was resolved that we write the Postmaster Ilkley regarding the delivery of letters in Addingham with special reference to Moorside pointing out it is 1pm before they are received

Noisy Manhole. It was resolved that the Rural District Council attention be drawn to the noisy manhole top opposite Mr Buckles shop

Last Bus on Sunday. It was resolved that the West Yorkshire Road Car Co be asked to restore the 10-20pm from Ilkley on Sunday evenings
