Approach to New Council Houses Burns Hill. Arising out of a letter received from the West Riding County Council stating that the roads approaching the New Council Estate was the District Council's responsibility it was resolved that we approach the District Council on the matter to ascertain what steps they propose in order that traffic danger can be eliminated

Damage to Property. In consequence of the continued damage to the Memorial Close Boundary walls it was resolved that police notice be posted intimating that future offenders could be prosecuted

Traffic Controls Crown Corner. It was resolved that Capt Drayson be thanked for his letter regarding Traffic Control Signals at the Crown Corner and that we hope to hear from him again when a further traffic check is made

Local Feast Holiday. It was resolved that we write the Postmaster Bradford stating that the Council agree to Addingham Post Office being closed on Monday and Tuesday 23<sup>rd</sup> & 24<sup>th</sup> July 1951 being the Local Feast Holiday

Noisy Manhole Covers. It was resolved that we write the Skipton Rural District Council;s engineer stating that the noisy manhole covers have not been repaired satisfactorily and will they give this matter further attention
